The 5th International Conference on Hands-on Science, HSCI2008, will be held in the science center of Pernambuco, Espaço Ciência, in the UNESCO World Heritage town of Olinda, Recife, in northeast Brazil from October 13 to 17, 2008.

In the footsteps of our successful previous conferences (www.hsci.info) attended by over 800 participants from 45 countries on 5 continents, with nearly five hundred different interesting and meaningful presentations, the 2008 Conference will again provide an ideal opportunity for presentation and open friendly discussion of all kinds of ideas experiences and works related to Science Education. For the first time the annual conference of the International Association Hands-on Science Network will take place outside the European Union. In Brazil very interesting pedagogical experiences were developed along the years. Oral and poster presentations

Oral presentations may be between 10 and 40 minutes in duration. Poster presentations will be available for the full duration of the meeting. An abstract of up to 300 words describing the main points and conclusions of the presentation is expected.

Discussion workshops, hands-on experiments demonstrations and Science fair

Sessions will be scheduled for the discussion of particular topics (such as science museums and informal learning, scientific literacy, women and science, migrants and minorities, science and society, ethics, R&D, life-long learning,...). Proposals for other workshops' topics are encouraged. Schools, research institutions, commercial companies, science clubs, teams and or groups of students or teachers, and individuals may prepare a booth to present their work at the Conference' Science Fair. A short abstract of no more than 500 words describing the activity must be submitted by July 25, 2008.

Informal contacts between participants are considered of utmost importance. A diversified social and cultural program will be offered. English is the official language of the Conference. Abstracts received in other languages before June 15 may also be accepted and translated into English.
